- Photo ID for all the adults in the household.
- Social Security Cards for everyone in the household
- Deduction and Credit information
- Child and dependent care expenses (day care provider's Tax ID number)
- W2s, 1099s and 1098s
- Form 1095A Affordable Care Act Declaration
- a copy of last year's Federal and State returns if available,
- bank routing numbers and account numbers for direct deposit.
